# Top Tips

- TAKE TIME
- Speak directly to the person
- Ask how person communicates
- Ask person to show you yes/no
- Use the AAC system
- · Try to elicit stories
- Develop topic boards
- · Give choices
- TAKE TIME

### DONT'S

- Don't be afraid
- Never accept that a person has no AAC
- Don't ignore the person
- Don't communicate only through carers
- · Don't guess too quickly
- AND DON'T ASSUME ANYTHING – don't be afraid to ask
