European Championships Success



Scots Maria Lyle, Ross Paterson, Jo Butterfield MBE, Stefanie Reid, Gavin Drysdale, Hannah Dines and Kayleigh Haggo competed at the 2018 WPA European Athletics Championships in Berlin, returning home with seven medals.

RaceRunning made its debut at the 2018 WPA European Athletics Championships in Berlin and three Scots, Gavin Drysdale, Hannah Dines and Kayleigh Haggo returned with two golds and a silver in the RR3 100m. Gavin Drysdale broke the World Record in the event.

Education and Coaching

- 101 training opportunities were delivered involving 1,608 candidates
- An external review of UK DIT reported that 99% of respondents had a positive impact
- 15 young people are being supported through a Leadership and Mentoring programme made possible through a grant by Big Lottery Young Start
- 8 Coach bursaries supported developing coaches
- Currently working with 15 universities and colleges to work towards embedding inclusion across tertiary education


